Subject: Resolution approving a 2nd Amendment to the Agreement with Economic Modeling, LLC for Workforce Development Software Licensing in the amount of \$15,000 for Neighborhood and Community Affairs Department, Workforce Partnerships and Special Projects Div
Resolution / Ordinance Title: A Resolution approving a Second Amendment to the Subscription Services Agreement between the City of Tampa and Economic Modeling, LLC for the provision of Workforce Development Software Licensing in the estimated amount of \$15,000 for use by the Neighborhood and Community Affairs Department, Workforce Partnerships and Special Projects Division; authorizing the Mayor to execute said Second Amendment to the Subscription Services Agreement; providing an effective date.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Tampa on September 19, 2024 entered into a Subscription Services Agreement (“Agreement”) dated June 3, 2024, and amended the Agreement to provide for annual renewals of the term of the subscription. The parties desire to enter a second amendment to the agreement to integrate and display Lightcast datasets on the City’s website.

There was no EBO Participation as this purchase is being made under a standardization.

That this Resolution approves a Second Amendment to the Economic Modeling, LLC Subscription Agreement between the City of Tampa and Economic Modeling, LLC to provide for the integration and display of Lightcast datasets on the City’s website in the amount of \$15,000 for use by the Neighborhood and Community Affairs Department, Workforce Partnerships and Special Projects Division within the General Fund.
