**Resolution / Ordinance Title:** A Resolution of the City of Tampa approving A Housing Program Funds Agreement for Homeowner Insurance Services between the City of Tampa and Real Estate, Education And Community Housing, Inc. for the provision of home insurance Services to low-to-moderate Income eligible clients participating in the Healthy Homes and/or Housing Rehabilitation Program, in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00; Authorizing execution by the Mayor and attestation by the City Clerk; Providing an Effective Date.

**BACKGROUND:**

The City is in need of an agency to provide home insurance services to low-to-moderate income eligible clients deemed eligible to receive home rehabilitation assistance through the City's Healthy Homes and/or Housing Rehabilitation and Renovation Program (HRRP), which services include assisting with securing home inspection services and obtaining hazard insurance for eligible homeowners. The City will provide up to one year of homeowner's insurance to eligible clients. Real Estate, Education and Community Housing, Inc. provides such services and will be reimbursed pursuant to the fee schedule using Housing Program Funds.

**FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT:**

This resolution approves an agreement to provide home insurance services to low-to-moderate income eligible clients deemed eligible to receive home rehabilitation assistance through the City's Healthy Homes and/or Housing Rehabilitation and Renovation Program (HRRP), which services include assisting with securing home inspection services and obtaining hazard insurance for eligible homeowners in an amount not to exceed \$75,000. Subrecipient shall be compensated on a reimbursement basis up to \$75,000 which is available for such purposes within the Housing and Community Development Department's Housing Program Funds.
